CONTINUING EDUCATION UNITS

This program is eligible for 6 continuing education units for Licensed Well Drilling Contractors and 6 continuing education units for Licensed Pump Installers or a total of 12 if you carry both licenses which are due by December 31, 2014!

Continuing Education for water well drillers and water well pump installers. It's the law.

As you know by now, the Indiana General Assembly passed IC 25-39-2-15.5 regarding pump installers license for water wells and continuing education. All pump installers must be licensed and are required to earn 6 hours continuing education units every 2 years. This became effective July 1, 2011. The continuing education offered at this conference will apply to the credit you need by December 31, 2014 for your 2015-2016 recertification.

Reminder this is the end of the 2 year cycle.

IDNR, Division of Water Update

The IDNR, Division of Water's administration of the Water Resources Management Act (IC 14-25-7) requires the registration of all Significant Water Withdrawal Facilities (SWWF) in the State of Indiana as well as annual water use reporting by these facilities. A SWWF is defined in the law as "the water withdrawal facilities of a person that, in the aggregate from all sources and by all methods, has the capability of withdrawing more than 100,000 gallons of ground water, surface water, or ground and surface water combined in one day". The first year of water use reporting by SWWFs occurred in 1985. Currently, there are about 4,030 SWWFs registered in the state, and 2013 reported water withdrawals by these facilities was nearly 2.73 trillion gallons.

Registered SWWFs are classified under the six following water use categories: Energy Production (EP); Industry (IN); Agricultural Irrigation (IR); Public Supply (PS); Miscellaneous (MI); and Rural Use (RU). Approximately 65% (2617) of the 4,030 total registered facilities are included in the "Agricultural Irrigation (IR)" water use category. The number of SWWFs in this category has increased significantly during the past few years as 388 new facilities (682 wells) have been added since 2010. Total reported ground water and surface water withdrawals for the IR water use category was approximately 76 billion gallons in 2013. By contrast, reported water withdrawals for the EP category in 2013 was nearly 1.6 trillion gallons.

National Ground Water Monitoring Network

The House FY 2015 Interior and Environment Appropriations Bill would provide funding to begin implementation of a National Ground Water Monitoring Network. "NGWA thanks the House Appropriations Committee members for their leadership and support for moving the network forward," stated NGWA Government Affairs Director Chris Reimer upon learning of the action. NGWA also thanks the Indiana Ground Water Association for lending their support. "Without the willingness of organizations, such as IGWA, to take a leadership role on groundwater-related issues, this effort would not have moved forward," noted Reimer.

Groundwater currently provides nearly half the nation's drinking water and more than 40 percent of irrigation water, rising to even higher levels during drought. Yet, efforts to monitor this valuable, hidden resource currently fall short. An understanding of groundwater's status and trends is inhibited by a lack of national coverage, inadequate periods of record, and inconsistency in measurement frequency, according to a government report. Envisioned as a cooperative venture among federal agencies, states, regional water authorities, and tribes, the NGWMN would function as an integrated system of data collection and reporting, and would provide the necessary data to more accurately monitor the nation's groundwater resources.

"NGWA and its member professionals stand ready to work with policymakers and others to address current and future water supply needs," notes Reimer. Ensuring access to adequate data will be critical to that effort.

Final action on FY 2015 funding bills is not expected until after the mid-year elections in November. NGWA looks forward to continuing to work with IGWA and our state affiliates on issues that impact groundwater and groundwater professionals' businesses. The NGWMN is just one example of that work.

INDIANA NEEDS TO ASSESS FUTURE DEMAND FOR WATER

Over the next 50 years, Indiana's ability to meet demands for clean, reliable water supplies could be hampered if a thorough assessment of our state's water resources is not an urgent priority.

We need a coordinated plan for determining the value of our existing water resources and protecting these supplies for the future, as a newly released study by the Indiana Chamber of Commerce Foundation indicates.

The situation is far from academic — water is essential to human life and plays a key role in the development and functioning of our society. Water is also a fundamental contributor to the economic health of our state.

A recent study found that more than 560,000 Hoosier jobs — about 23 percent of our total employment — are in industries that rely on water, giving Indiana the greatest percentage of water-related jobs in the nation. Food processing and manufacturing plants, the pharmaceutical industry and agriculture

are among our state's industries that depend on water.

The decisions we make today on how to manage and protect our water will impact Indiana's future employment and economic viability.

We need to conduct a better assessment of our statewide groundwater resources if we are to effectively manage their use. Locating, mapping and modeling our resources are critical steps to planning the location of new businesses and residential areas and ensuring that the demands of our growing population do not deplete our groundwater supply faster than it can be replenished. Failing to fully understand our resources can lead to empty wells and a dry tap in the kitchen sink.

Without water resource planning at the local and national levels, we will be unable to develop new sources of water and cannot capture the true value of our existing supplies. Furthermore, we become vulnerable to the potential

impacts of a changing climate, uncertainty in water supply locations and uncertainty related to wastewater management.

While parallels between water and energy production are often made, it is critical to remember that energy can be generated in a variety of ways, but the amount of water on Earth is fixed: What we do now will significantly impact the availability and distribution of our water supply, both in our state and around the globe.

Indiana is empowered by water, but that power is not without limits. We must take stock of our valuable resources to better plan for the future of our state.

Turco is a Purdue University professor of agronomy, the director of the Purdue Water Community and the director of the Indiana Water Resources Research Center.

The Indiana Ground Water Association Supports Purdue Research Proposal

Purdue University and University of Illinois along with other institutions are working to develop a five year research proposal to the USDA NIFA Water for Agriculture program with the ultimate goal of developing science-based management and policy strategies for sustainable water management in northern Indiana and Illinois and southern Wisconsin and Michigan for the next several decades. Lyndon Kelley from MSU/Purdue extension recommended the IGWA provide a representative on their advisory panel.

Should the proposal be funded, they will be interested in getting our expert opinion on their research outputs, as well as gaining our advice throughout the project so their research can be relevant to a diverse set of stakeholders. They would solicit our feedback through participation in an annual project meeting, support in identifying appropriate stakeholder groups and through reviewing of documents.

The IGWA Board of Directors will determine who will best serve in this capacity should the proposal be accepted. We will keep you updated on their progress.
