FMCSA DRUG AND ALCOHOL CLEARINGHOUSE

All employers and CDL holders, as of January 6, 2020, are now required to register with the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration Drug and Alcohol Clearinghouse. Those that have not registered can find all the information and links to register at: https://clearinghouse.fmcsa.dot.gov/.

This is an online database that gives employers and government agencies real-time access to information about CDL driver drug and alcohol program violations. The goal of the program is to make roads safer as information from all states will now be accessible by employers.

Each employer must register as a company and then all of your CDL drivers must also register themselves.




